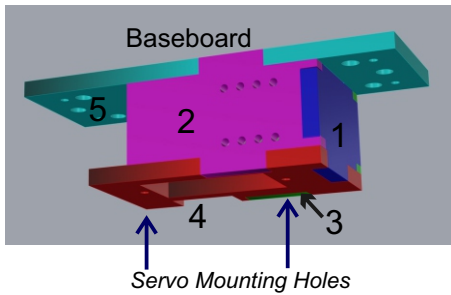
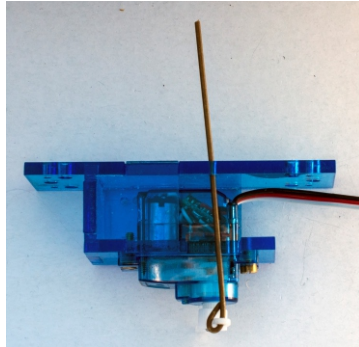


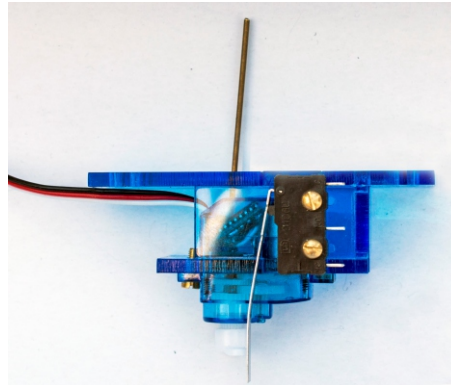
# Brunel Models Servo Mount - Instructions



The servo mounts downwards (as shown above).  
Part 5 is screwed to your baseboard - a number of holes are provided to facilitate this.  
They can be easily drilled to a larger size if desired.  
The servo mounting holes can be tapped for an 8BA screw if desired.  
A micro-switch can be mounted using the holes in the side of part 2.  
The microswitch is available from Jaycar (SM1038).

A length of brass wire can be used to connect the servo to the point switch mechanism. It is not necessary to use piano wire as "spring" is not required to keep the switch blades closed.



A microswitch can be mounted on the side of the servo mount as shown.
